The International Society of Pneumonia and Pneumococcal Diseases (ISPPD) is a non-profit, non-governmental association and has its headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland. The ISPPD was officially launched on 11 March 2012 during the ISPPD-8 Symposium in Foz de Iguaçu, Brazil. Currently, the main activity of the ISPPD is the biennial ISPPD international meeting, which is the leading event for those interested in pneumococci and pneumococcal diseases, bringing together professionals in the field to raise global awareness and improve standards of diagnosis, prevention, and treatment.

The rationale for creating ISPPD originated with the need for a legal framework for the ISPPD Meeting. Initiated in 1998 at the 1st meeting in Denmark, ISPPD meetings have been organised every two years in different countries with local sponsors. The number of delegates has grown significantly over the years, and each of the past few meetings has welcomed over 1000 delegates.

The ISPPD Mission is to improve the knowledge and understanding of pneumonia biology, pathogenesis, and epidemiology, the host response to important pneumonia pathogens carried in the upper respiratory trac,t and the prevention and treatment of pneumonia.


